Deaths Directly Linked to Marijuana Use:

We have been tracking news reports of child abuse and neglect linked to marijuana since November 2012. The columns show official causes of death related to the caregivers' marijuana use. We found news reports of 96 such deaths in 28 states; actual number could be much higher. Violent neglect includes marijuana DUI (9), guns (4) and pit bulls. The last column includes infants (8) who died shortly after birth.
